Summary

Should the nine (9) CopVu body worn body cameras be given to the Weatherby Lakes Police Department for their use?

Background

The Platte City Police Department currently possesses nine (9) CopVu body worn cameras that we have purchased through WatchGuard beginning in late 2010. Due to the recent upgrade to the WatchGuard Vista body worn camera system the CopVu body worn cameras will no longer be used as we continue moving forward with the City's efforts to upgrade our technology security by eliminating servers and going to work group/cloud based systems.

Analysis

The CopVu body worn cameras will not be used and will not be returned to service as it is a server based system. The videos from the old CopVu body worn cameras will be maintained until no longer needed for court or the retention period expires.

Gary McMullin, Chief of Police for the Weatherby Lake Police Department has requested the CopVu body worn cameras be donated to the Weatherby Lake Police Department.

Alternatives

Dispose of the CopVu body worn cameras in another manner.

Legal Impact

There should be no legal impact; the video library will be maintained on 1TB portable external hard drive that complies with current records retention.

Fiscal Impact:

Due to the fact the CopVu Cameras are no longer supported by WatchGuard they have little value. Donating the CopVu Cameras to another police agency would have no financial impact on the City of Platte City.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends the CopVu Cameras and all of the accessories for them be donated to the Weatherby Lake Police Department. Although the CopVu Cameras are obsolete for our purposes and some of them are showing their age with slightly reduced battery lives they should function properly until the Weatherby Lake Police Department can obtain the funds to replace them.

Dear Chief Mitchell,



A RESOLUTION DECLARING SPECIFIC ITEMS AS SURPLUS TO CITY REQUIREMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO DISPOSE OF SUCH ITEMS

Subj: Discussion/Guidance Request to Update Vehicle Tow and Boot Ordinance

Summary: Staff requests guidance from the subcommittee regarding possible changes to the City towing regulations to reflect changes in state statute and to consider adding a section on the use of vehicle immobilization devices (boots). This is a discussion item only. Guidance from the subcommittee will determine if any legislative documents will be developed for future subcommittee and board consideration.

Background: The City's current towing ordinance was last amended in 2004. The ordinance adopted at that time was consistent with the state statutes (RsMO 304.155 etc) on both public and private property towing. These statutes have been amended several times since the 2004 City ordinance update. Specific issues related to possible changes to the City towing ordinance will be presented in the analysis section of this report.

The existing City ordinance on public and private towing does not contain any mention of vehicle immobilization (vehicle booting) a practice that is relatively new to Platte City, although widespread in many urban areas and larger communities. Over the past several months, the Police Department has become involved in a number of incidents involving private property owners placing a boot on a vehicle parked on their property and requiring payment to release the vehicle. While the City's existing towing ordinance (and state statute) contains specific conditions under which a private property owner may tow a vehicle, the ordinance does not address vehicle immobilization (booting).

Other fourth class communities who have addressed vehicle immobilization issue in the past five years have generally chosen to update the towing ordinance to reflect post 2004 changes in state statute and place private property immobilization under the same conditions as currently exist for private property towing.

Analysis:

The purpose of state and local towing and vehicle immobilization regulations is to provide both public agencies and private property owners a mechanism for removing illegally or improperly parked vehicles while also protecting vehicle owners from arbitrary towing/immobilization and predatory towing/release fees.

The current city ordinance mirrors state statute in providing the following conditions for towing by City (agency or police officers)

Towing from Public Property/Public Right of Way by Police or City

- a. City may tow immediately if officer determines vehicle is hazard or impounded for criminal/traffic violation

- b. If not immediate hazard, City may tow vehicle if it remains on public property/RoW 48 hours after a notice is placed on the vehicle.

Towing from Private Property by Police or City

- a. On the request of the private property owner, City may tow vehicle from private property if vehicle is left unattended for more than 48 hours or;
- b. City may tow vehicle from private property at any time, provided the officer determines that the vehicle constitutes a safety hazard or unreasonably interferes with the use of real property by the person in possession.

Different conditions and regulations apply with the towing is directed or authorized by a private property owner (without involvement of City agency or police officer).

Towing from Private Property by Private Property Owner

- a. A private property owner may authorize/direct a towing company to remove privately owned vehicle only under the following conditions;
 - 1. Owner or full time employee/agent of private property must be present
 - 2. All entrances to property must be posted with sign of specified size and language
 - 3. If private property is four units or less, AND, owner has notified police department, the vehicle can be towed when left unattended for 10 hours.
 - 4. Any other private property (commercial/retail/large apartments) the owner must notify police department AND vehicle must be unattended for 96 hours prior to tow.
 - 5. Private property owners may tow from their property without prior notice to police, although they must then file a report within 2 hours with police department including an affidavit that they have complied with all provisions of the law as if the police had received prior notice.

Fees: State statute and City ordinance 390 allow the Board of Aldermen to establish a fee schedule for private property towing, although it does not appear the Board has chosen to adopt a maximum fee other than that established in state statute.

The City code currently contains no conditions regarding the use of vehicle immobilization devices for either public or private property.

Discussion items: Developing conditions for use of vehicle immobilization devices. Fee schedule for nuisance/abatement towing or immobilization. Identify stakeholders and other interested parties to include in discussion of these issues.

Recommendation: No action requested. Discussion only.
