Ways to pay your Platte City Utility Bill

Did you know that you can pay with your credit or debit card? If you visit us on our website, www.plattecit.org, go to online payments and fill out the payment information. You can also pay by phone or in person with your card. There will be a small convenience charge based on your amount of the bill.

You can also set City of Platte City up as a payee through your bank and let them send your payment to the City. Just remember the City is not yet set up for electronic bank payments, so your bank will have to mail the check to us. Give your bank 3 to 5 days to get the check to us.

If you would like for the City to automatic draft your payment out of your checking or savings account, just come in to fill out the paperwork and bring in a voided check or deposit slip.

You can pay your bills by mail, in person, or drop your payments in the drop box located off Fourth Street outside City Hall. **Call City Utilities at 858-3046 for more information about automatic payment options.**

CONGRATULATIONS for 100% RECYCLING INCREASE

Thanks to all Platte City residents who have been willing to take advantage of the new recycling carts. November 2013, the first month with the new carts, had a recycling volume of more than 40,000 pounds. This volume is just over a 100% increase from the 20,000 pounds collected in November of 2012. Every ton of recycling saves more than \$34/ton in land fill fees as well as bringing in almost \$30 per ton in material sales. Call Public Works at 858-4815 with any recycling questions or ideas.

Be A Responsible Pet Owner

Sharing your life with a dog or cat can be a source of great joy. However, having a pet also comes with responsibilities both to your pet and to your neighbors.. Following are a few tips for responsible pet ownership:

- Spay or Neuter your dog or cat. Contact your local veterinarian or City Hall for more information.
- Accept responsibility if your dog or cat does have a litter. Contact the Great Plains SPCA, Wayside Waifs or City Hall for assistance or more information.
- Do not abandon animals and hope for the best. Contact the Great Plains SPCA, Wayside Waifs or City Hall for assistance or more information.
- Vaccinate and license your pets. Vaccines prevent the spread of disease, licensing helps bring your pet home.
- Dog owners should be aware of their dogs barking habits. Do not allow constant barking to impact your neighbor's ability to enjoy their property. Bring barking dogs inside or train your dogs to limit their barking.
- Don't leave Christmas gifts in garages or sheds
- If your Christmas tree is in a window, don't put gifts around it until Christmas morning.

The Platte City Yard Waste Drop Off facility at the west end of Mill Street in Riverview Park will reopen to accept Christmas Trees only during daylight hours from Sat. Dec 28th through Sun, Jan 12th. Trees must have all tinsel and flock removed. The facility use is restricted to Platte City residential solid waste customers only.
