MAKE IT EASIER TO PAY YOUR UTILITY BILL

On line CREDIT/ DEBIT Card: Set up your monthly credit or debit payments at www.plattecitey.org/online. Convenience fee applies to this option.

Bank Check Payment: Set up City of Platte City as a payee through your bank and let them send your payment to the City. Give your bank 3 to 5 days to get the check to us.

Automatic Bank Draft: Your bank can automatically make your payment each month with this option. Fill out application at City Hall along with voided check.

Pay by mail or in person at City Hall, 400 Main Street. After hours drop box on Fourth Street

Call in credit or debit payments at 858-3046. Convenience fee applies for this option.

August is Primacy Fee Month on Your Water Bill
Every August your city utility bill includes a charge shown on the bill as the "Primacy Fee". This is a one time per year pass through of a state fee to partially fund the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) water and wastewater inspection and environmental compliance programs.

Every state regulated water and wastewater utility in Missouri is required to collect this fee for DNR.

The fee is based on meter size. The Primacy Fee charge for a standard residential customer is \$3.70. Anyone with a meter that is larger than a standard residential meter will have a higher primacy fee. Contact Utility Billing at 858-3046 with any questions
