

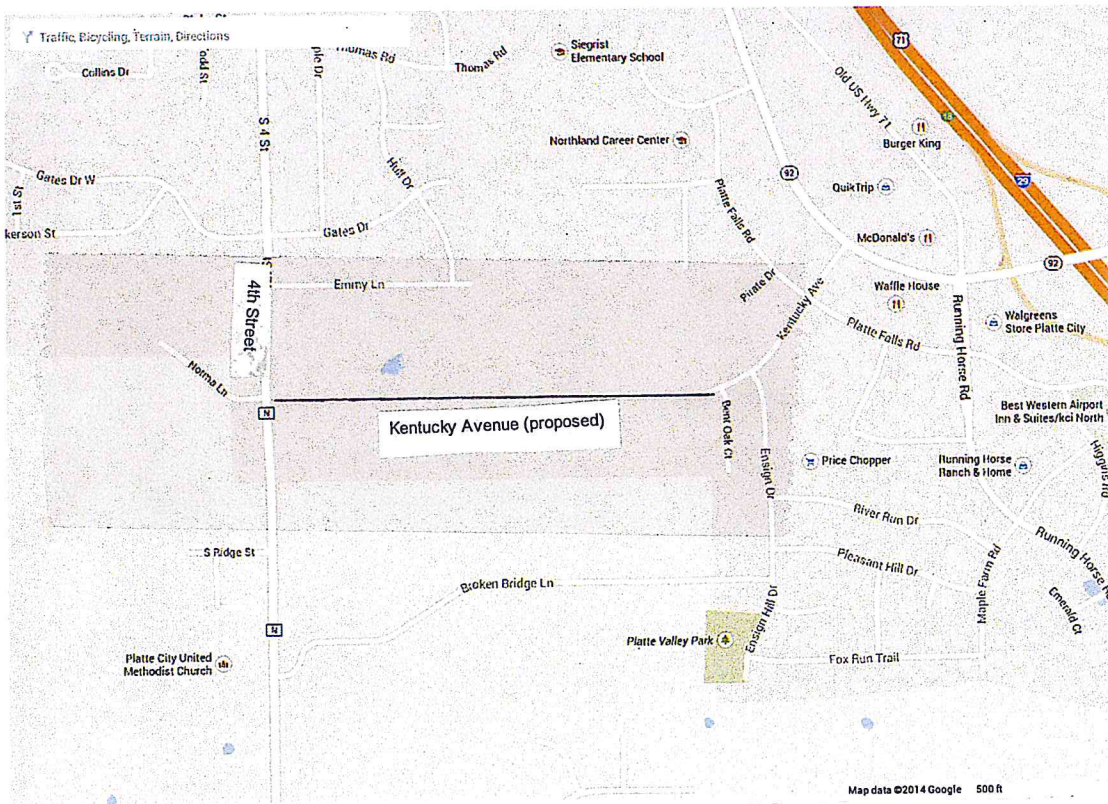

Kentucky Avenue Completion
 Vote set for November 4th

Bond to complete Kentucky Avenue from Price Chopper to Fourth Street

The November 4th election ballot includes a question asking Platte City voters to authorize the City to issue \$2.7 million in General Obligation bonds to pay for completing Kentucky Avenue from its current dead end at Bent Oak (near Price Chopper) west to 4th Street (near Norma Drive).

This project will complete Kentucky Avenue as a four lane connection between the Platte Valley Market business/retail area and the 4th Street corridor. Completing Kentucky Avenue will reduce congestion on Highway 92, reduce traffic on Broken Bridge and reduce cut through traffic in the Platte Valley Estates residential area. A sketch map showing the general road alignment is below:

RECYCLING REMINDERS

- ♦ Green Recycling Bins are for Recyclable Material Only; Do not use Green Bin for trash
- ♦ List of acceptable recyclable material is printed on top of green recycling bins
- ♦ Glass is now longer acceptable for curbside recycling.
- ♦ Glass recycling is by drop off only at Ripple Glass container at Price Chopper or public glass drop off bin at City Public Works Building 108 Paxton Street

City crews will stick a notice on your recycling bin the first two times glass and trash is found in the recycling bin. City crews will remove bin from service if customer continues to use the bin for glass and trash.
