The City's annual spring clean-up will be here soon! Spring Clean up is scheduled for April 18-21, 2017. Large and bulky items will be picked up on your regular trash pick-up day; please have items out at the curb by 6:30 a.m.



The following items will be picked up free of charge during the spring clean up event only: " Brush and small limbs (cut to 4' lengths and bundled) " Yard waste – leaves and grass clippings (bagged in paper bags only) " Tires (limit of 4 per household) " Appliances " Furniture Please note that the City **cannot** accept building materials (i.e. lumber, sheetrock, plaster, concrete, siding materials), carpet, insulation or roofing material.

***Only items placed at the curb on the regular pick-up day will be considered for this free service. Other items may be picked up at the resident's request, and regular bulky item pick-up fees will be charged. If you have questions, please contact Public Works at 816-858-4815.**

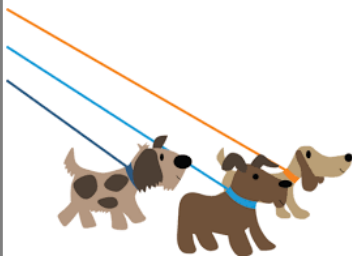

Be a Courteous Dog Walker...

The City of Platte City would like to remind you of the following requirements when walking with your pet:

Leash Up – The City requires all pets to be on a leash to protect you, your pet and others. A leash will keep you in control during the walk and ensure that your pet does not slip away.

Clean Up – It is your responsibility to clean up after your pet. The City requires clean up in all areas, especially in parks and around trails and sidewalks. Keep the peace by not leaving a mess.

Sidewalk repair cost share program

The City's cost share program can help ease the financial burden of sidewalk upkeep and replacement.
