Parking and Fence Permits



Residential parking is only allowed on hard surfaces. Parking in a yard or on a grassy area is not permitted.

Fence Permit: Does your fence need replaced? A fence permit is required to replace or install a fence. Permit paperwork is available on the City website or at City Hall. No permit fees are assessed for fences.
