The City's annual spring clean-up will be here soon! Spring Clean up is scheduled for April 24th—27th. Large and bulky items will be picked up on your regular trash pick-up day; please have items out at the curb by 6:30 a.m.

The following will be picked up free of charge during the spring clean up event only:

- Bundled 4' lengths of brush and small limbs
- Paper bags of yard waste (leaves and grass)
- Tires (limit of 4 per household)
- Appliances
- Furniture

***Only items placed at the curb on the regular pick-up day will be considered for this free service. Other items may be picked up at the resident's request, and regular bulky item pick-up fees will be charged. If you have questions, please contact Public Works at 816-858-4815.**

Please note that the City **cannot** accept building materials (i.e. lumber, sheetrock, plaster, concrete, siding materials), carpet, insulation or roofing material.

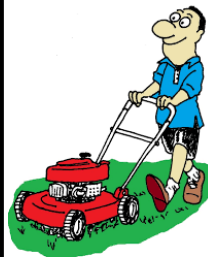


Grass Cutting Reminder

Codes Reminders

Parking

Residential parking is permitted on hard surfaces only. Parking in a yard or on any grassy area is prohibited.

Fence Permit

A permit is required to replace or install a fence. Permit paperwork is available on the City website or at City Hall. No permit fees are assessed for fences.

Sheds & Residential Decks

A permit is required to replace, construct or place a new shed or deck.

Sidewalk Repair Cost Share Program

Property owners are responsible for maintaining the sidewalk in front and alongside their property. The City cost share program can ease the financial burden of sidewalk upkeep and replacement by cutting repair costs in half.
