The green waste facility opens on March 1, 2018 for Platte City residents.

Purchase or renew your 2018 green waste facility access card now for a \$20 annual fee.

New access cards can be purchased at City Hall Monday-Friday 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. except on observed holidays. Renew your access card and add the \$20 annual fee to your next bill.

The green waste facility is available for individual, residential green waste (yard debris, grass clippings, brush, tree branches etc.) and is located in Riverview Park at the end of Mill St. Commercial use prohibited.

## Apply now for 2017-18 Property Revitalization Matching Grants

The City is still accepting applications from Platte City property owners for the 2017-18 residential and downtown business matching grant programs.

Eligible property owners can be reimbursed up to 50% of the cost of business and home improvement projects. Homeowners can receive a grant of up to \$10,000; business owners can receive a grant of up to \$20,000.

Applications will be reviewed and eligible projects approved on a first come, first served basis until all grant funds have been awarded. The program helps increase property values by providing a financial incentive for property owners to reinvest in their home or downtown business.

### Codes Reminders

#### Parking

Residential parking is permitted on hard surfaces only. Parking in a yard or on any grassy area is prohibited.



#### Fence Permit

A permit is required to replace or install a fence. Permit paperwork is available on the City website or at City Hall. No permit fees are assessed for fences.

#### Sheds & Residential Decks

A permit is required to replace, construct or place a new shed or deck.
