## City Street Funding on November Ballot



The November election ballot includes a measure asking Platte City voters whether or not to extend the City's existing  $\frac{3}{8}$  cents transportation sales tax for an additional 20 years. Approval of the extension maintains the dedicated street funding tax at its current level. Approval of the measure improves the ability of the City to conduct long term street maintenance and construction planning and allows the City to commit funds to specific street projects, including but not limited to signal improvements to the intersection of Kentucky Avenue and Platte Falls Road, improvements to West Gates/Fourth Street intersection and the annual street maintenance program. Disapproval of the ballot measure reduces the overall City sales tax rate by  $\frac{3}{8}$  cents when the current sales tax term expires and reduces funds dedicated to the City street program.
