



Holiday Lighting Ceremony November 21, 2018 5:30 p.m.

The community is invited to the annual holiday lighting ceremony on Main Street in downtown Platte City.

This free family event has activities for all ages: Santa's reindeer, horse drawn carriage rides, face painting, balloon artist, holiday make it-take it, children's Main Street "sticker stop" game, visit the Snow Princess, refreshments and visit with Santa and Mrs. Claus.



Free hotdogs, chili, chips, cookies and water will be at the Central Platte Fire District Building at Third and Main Street. Other treats will be available on Main Street. Food trucks will be on Third Street with items available for purchase.



A free shuttle service from the Platte County RIII High School to downtown will be provided. The Trolleys will leave the high school parking lot beginning at 4:45 p.m. and will run every 15-20 minutes. Drop off and pick up downtown will be at the intersection of Fourth and Main Street and Second and Main Street.

Final pick up downtown will be at 9:00 p.m. to return riders to the Platte County High School parking lot.

Winter Weather

Platte City's top priority in a snowstorm is plowing snow routes, which may require several trips down the same route. Snow plowed from roads could block private driveways for some time. Due to limited time and resources during a snow event, plows can only clear private driveways at the request of local emergency officials.

To reduce the amount of snow that may block your driveway, shovel an open area along the shoulder at the entrance. Plow blades will then push snow into the area just before your driveway and leave a much smaller amount of snow in front of your driveway.
