CITY SNOW ROUTE CLEARING TIPS

Platte City's top priority during a snowstorm is plowing snow routes. Clearing snow routes may require several trips.

Tips to assist clearing of City streets:

- When a snow storm is forecast, please refrain from parking on City streets.
- During a snow event, on street parking is prohibited on all emergency snow routes.
- To reduce the amount of snow that may block your driveway, remove snow along the shoulder of the street for 8-10 feet before your driveway entrance.

Candidate filing opens December 11, 2018 and closes January 15, 2019. Candidates may file for the offices listed below with the City Clerk during business hours Monday-Friday 8:00 a.m. to Noon and 1:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m.

- Alderman of Ward One 2 Year Term
- Alderman of Ward Two 2 Year Term
- Alderman of Ward Three 2 Year Term



Qualifications for declaration of candidacy Alderman:

- At least 18 years of age
- Registered voter
- A resident of Platte City for 1 year prior to the election (Must have been a resident of Platte City no later than April 2, 2018 to be eligible)
- A resident of the ward in which you are filing
