## **Mill and Overlay Project Invitation to Bid**

1. **PROJECT:** Annual asphalt street rehabilitation program to include replacing approximately 6,602 feet of CG-2 rolled concrete curb and mill and overlay of approximately 1.34 lane miles (approx 9,450 sq yard) of residential street. City crews will remove existing concrete curbs and gutters.
  
2. **BIDS RECEIVED UNTIL:** 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, March 27, 2019, at City Hall, 400 Main Street, Platte City, Missouri, at which time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.
  
3. **DESCRIPTION OF WORK:**  
Furnish all labor, equipment, traffic control and materials as necessary to install CG-2 rolled concrete curb, complete mill and overlay on streets as detailed in Project Description Section. Coordinate contract work schedule with City removal of existing curb and gutter to minimize project impact.  
  
The 2” milling, hauling, sweeping and placement of 2” thick Type II asphaltic surface on streets as detailed in Project Description Section. Alternate bid price for recycled material; 20-25% RAC acceptable with no shingles allowed. City to retain milled material. Contractor to deliver millings to City PW Yard (612 First Street) and City WWTP area (99 Mill Street).
  
4. **ALL BIDS** must be in accordance with the Bid Documents. Bids will be received on a unit price basis for the street improvements.
  
5. **WORK TIMING:** The work is to be commenced within fifteen calendar days after the Notice to Proceed is issued. Rapid completion of the work is desired.
  
6. **PREVAILING WAGE:** Pursuant to RSMo section 290 not less than the prevailing hourly rate of wages, as set out in Missouri Division of Labor Standards Annual Wage Order 25 (3/9/18) must be paid to all workers performing work on this project. Bidder will be required to submit Prevailing Wage Affidavit at completion of project. Copy of Wage Order 25 is available upon request.
  
7. **BIDDER’S QUESTIONS AND COMMENTS** relative to these bidding documents should be submitted to Kenny Loy, Public Works Director at 816-858-4815. Comments should reach this office no later than eight calendar days prior to the date set for opening of bids, in order that changes, if needed, may be added by addendum.
  
8. **PRE-BID CONFERENCE:** Will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 19 at 400 Main Street, Platte City, Missouri. Representatives of owner will be present to answer questions.
  
9. **BIDDERS Subcontracting.** on this work are required to name subcontractors and manufacturers on the Bid Form.

**10. AWARD OF THE CONTRACT** will be made on the basis of the lowest responsive, responsible evaluated bid. Payment for work under this contract will be made on the basis set forth in the General Conditions.

**11. BID ACCEPTANCE OR REJECTION:** Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or any portion thereof, and to waive irregularities therein, including without limitation the rights to reject any or all nonconforming, nonresponsive, unbalanced or conditional Bids and to reject the bid of any Bidder if Owner believes that it would not be in the best interest of the Project to make an award to that Bidder, whether because the Bid is not responsive or the Bidder is unqualified or of doubtful financial ability or fails to meet any other pertinent standard or criteria established by the Owner. Owner also reserves the right to waive all informalities not involving price, time or changes in the Work and to negotiate contract terms with the Successful Bidder. All Bidders must agree that such rejection shall be without liability on the part of the Owner for any damage or claim brought by any Bidder because of such rejections, and the filing of any Bid in response to this invitation shall constitute an agreement of the Bidder to these conditions.

**12. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:** Bidders must be properly licensed under the state laws governing their respective trade. Insurance in a form acceptable to the City will be required of the successful bidder.

**13. BUSINESS LICENSE;** Winning bidder and any subcontractors must obtain City business license prior to start of project.

**15. PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS:**

**Concrete Curb Replacement**

**City shall:**

- a. City crews will perform all required tear-out work and will verify rock base is sufficient for forming and installation of new curb.
- b. Backfill curb following contractor removal of forms.

**Contractor shall:**

- c. Pour CG-2 style 2' curb with 11" back and 6" face. String lines shall be used to set all forms to a uniform grade and shall be inspected by City prior to pouring.
- d. Sawed or grooved joints shall be provided every 10 feet and fiber joints every 36 feet in the new curbs and at every drive and sidewalk abutment.
- e. Backfilling will be done by City; contractor shall remove spoils from project as forms are being removed.

- f. Due to parking limitations: tear out, and curb replacement schedules shall be coordinated with city and contractor shall place communication hangers at least three days prior to start of curb replacement.
- g. Concrete shall cure for at least three days before allowing travel across it.
- h. All concrete shall be six sack 4,000 ps mix with Meramec sand and gravel.
- i. Contractor shall provide barricades or cones at 10 feet intervals and extras at any closed sidewalks.
- j. Payment for this item shall be per foot.
- k. Contractor is responsible for all traffic control necessary to perform work.
- l. Contractor shall work with City to notify residents of planned driveway limitations.
- m. Contractor shall sweep up all spoils and take protective measures to keep all materials out of storm sewers. Sweeping may be required at contractors expense.

**Mill and Overlay**

- n. Street Milling: The Contractor Unit Price bid for this item shall constitute full compensation for 2” edge milling, hauling and sweeping and traffic control; streets to be clear and ready for overlay.
- o. City to retain milled material; material to be hauled City PW yard 612 First Street and City WWTP 99 Mill Street.
- p. 2” Asphaltic Concrete Street Surface: The Contract Unit Price bid for this item shall constitute full compensation for furnishing all materials, labor, equipment and tools for the construction of a 2” thick course of Type II asphaltic concrete surface material. This item includes all material, compaction, seal coating, batch plant testing, material quality monitoring, hauling, maintenance of haul road, permits and all work and materials necessary to complete the work in accordance with the Bid Documents. Payment for this item shall be per ton placed.
- q. Contractor is responsible for all traffic control necessary to perform work.

It is the intent of the Owner to have curb and base preparation complete before contractor. All material criteria will be latest edition APWA Standards. This is a per-ton laid in place project. All material, tack coat, equipment, compaction, labor and pre-cleaning will be in price per ton laid in place. Owner will need 7-day prior notice of start of project to relocate traffic. Owner stipulates that haul trucks be limited to 25 tons due to residential zoning area.
